Training Overview

This IFS training builds on the experiences of the Level 1 training. It follows a similar format, including didactic content, demonstrations, experiential large group exercises, and small group practice sessions. Like Level 1, this Level 2 intensive training places equal emphasis on theory and personal experiential work.

Focus Areas

- Working with extreme protective systems and early childhood trauma
- Deepening core IFS processes: working with inner polarizations, intense firefighters, and unburdening
- Strengthening the therapeutic relationship through personal experiential work
- A deeper understanding of the Self—of both client and therapist—with rich opportunities for self-exploration

Methods

- Lectures
- Demonstration sessions
- Supervised practice groups
- Large group discussions
- Reflection groups
- Personal experiential work

Language

- The training is conducted in English.

Food & Drinks

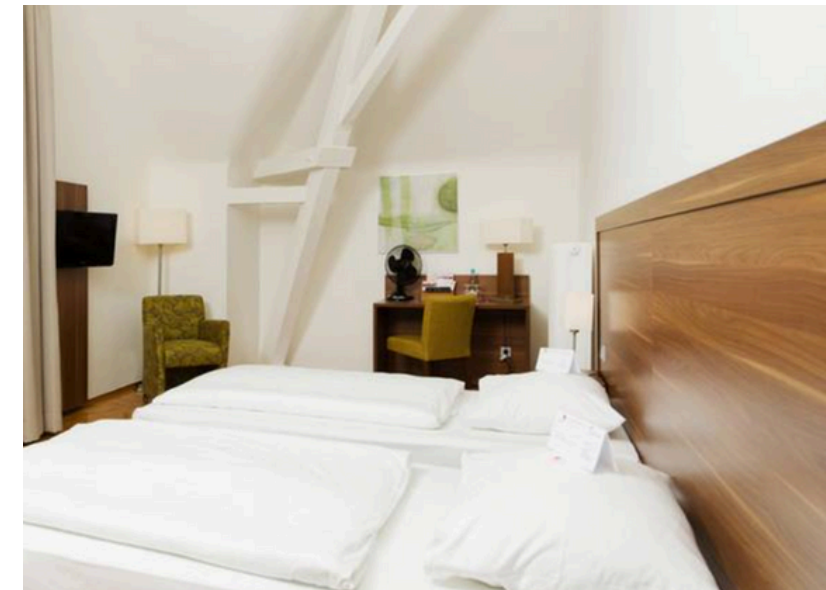

Application

- Prerequisite: Completion of the IFS Level 1 Training
- Please fill out our application form (published soon on our website and via newsletter).
- You can apply for the Level 2 Training from September 1 to October 15, 2025.
- All applicants will receive a response by November 15, 2025.

Please note:

- Recording by participants is not permitted
- Online participation is not possible

Certification

- Upon completion of the training, you will receive a certificate of participation from the international IFS Institute (requirement: attendance of at least 27 out of 32 training hours).
- Important: Participation in a training does not mean that you are automatically certified.
- To become a certified IFS Therapist or IFS Practitioner, you must complete a separate certification process with the international IFS Institute (IFSI).
- Accreditation with the relevant Chamber of Psychotherapists: 51 points (Germany)
- This certificate allows you to participate to IFS Level 3 trainings

- The Level 2 Training costs €2,500 (VAT-exempt)
